### **National Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Council Announces Endorsement of Yesli Vega for Congress**

From her lived experience of having a close family member nearly murdered by MS-13 to serving in three different Northern Virginia law enforcement agencies, Supervisor Vega has first-hand knowledge of the types of crimes committed by those here illegally in Northern Virginia and throughout the 7th District and has pledged to support ICE officers in their critical public safety and national security missions.
